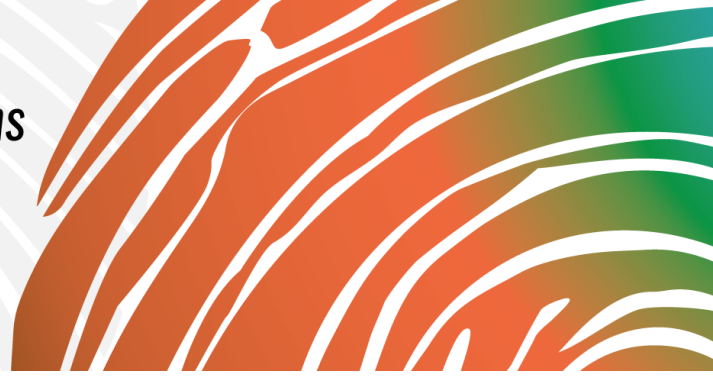

The Voice of First Nations Tourism



The QFNTC is working closely with QTIC, State and National Government, and Industry to drive forward the implementation of the Queensland First Nations Tourism Plan 2020-2025 and strengthen the voice of First Nations tourism in Queensland.

QFNTC has a 100% all-Indigenous Interim Board that will be actively engaging with the regions to form a solid membership base to hold the first formal election of 6 regional directors, chosen by our members, in the second half of 2022.

In 2022 as part of the inaugural year celebrations the QFNTC are waiving fees for First Nations Tourism Organisations to become a Full Corporate Member. We are also waiving fees for industry organisations to become Associate Members.

More information on the three levels of membership is below.

FIRST NATIONS BUSINESS

This category of Membership is for First Nation Tourism organisations that want to be a member of the organisation and receive benefits but not vote on who is their Regional Director for the Board.

FULL CORPORATE

This category of Membership is for First Nation Tourism Organisations that want to vote on who gets elected as their Regional Director who sits and makes decisions on the QFNTC Board.

ASSOCIATE

This category is for non-First Nation tourism organisations, non-tourism First Nations organisations (eg Health and environment organisations), industry organisations and peak bodies, and government (eg a local or Aboriginal Shire council) to be non-voting associated members of QFNTC that receive benefits from QFNTC .
